- Approval of the project client(s) to the nomination must be provided.
- The Nominee must be a Queensland-based employee.
- Only one nominee per company for each People's Award category will be accepted.
- Submissions that exceed the stated word limits may be marked down or deemed ineligible.

7. Any other issues or factors that may be relevant to the judging panel in their consideration of the Nominee (both positive and negative)? (maximum 250 words).
