

CCF CODE V10

The primary purpose of the CCF Code is to assist contractor businesses in achieving and maintaining compliance relevant to industry standards and regulations, required by federal and/or state authorities.

The code draws together elements of quality, work health and safety and environmental management in one system.

Accredited by the Joint Accreditation System of Australia and New Zealand (JAS-ANZ) for third party certification, the code is designed to be used in isolation of, or in combination with other certification standards such as ISO.

The CCF Code is supported by a Management System Reference Documents designed to help businesses manage their compliance with the CCF Code. Members have access to the CCF Code V10 at a discounted rate.

MANAGEMENT SYSTEM REFERENCE DOCUMENTS

The Civil Contractors Federation Management Code is accompanied by the Management System Reference Documents (MSRD) containing suggested templates for plans, policies, registers, and forms that may be used in the development of an Integrated Management System.

The MSRD comprises of over 90 documents which cover off on the following categories:
